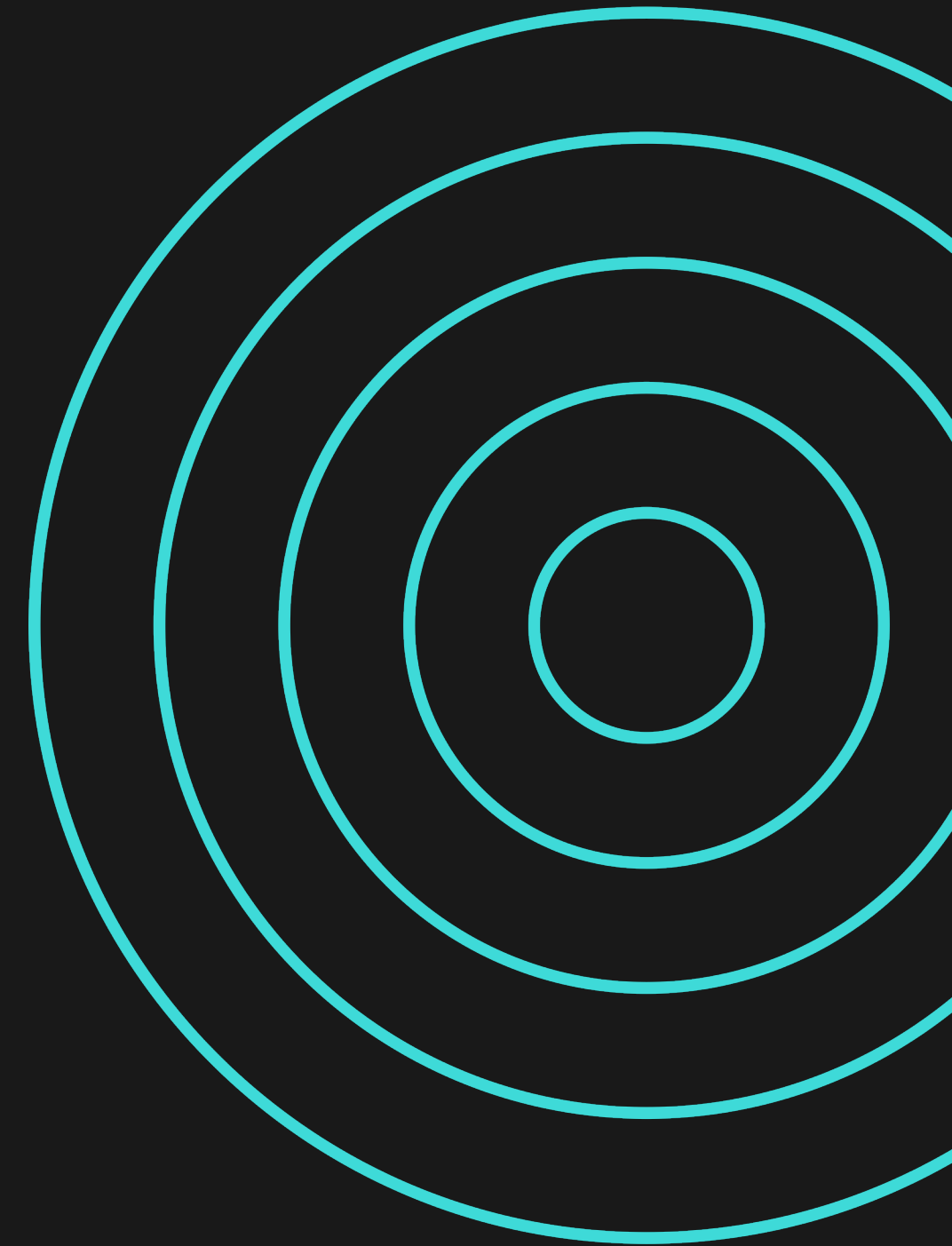

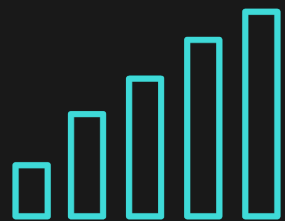

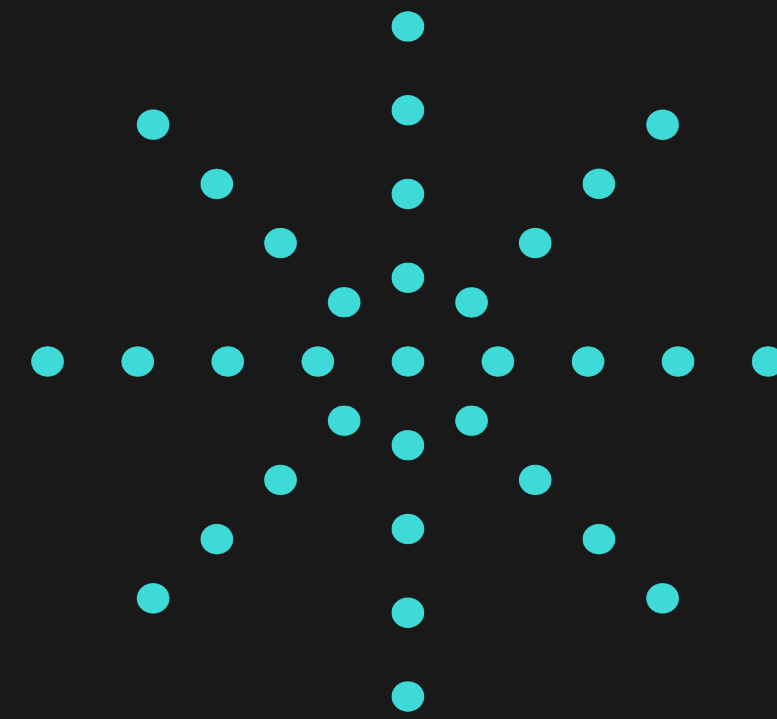
RELEASE PROCESS OWNED BY QA TEAM

- Stable release schedule

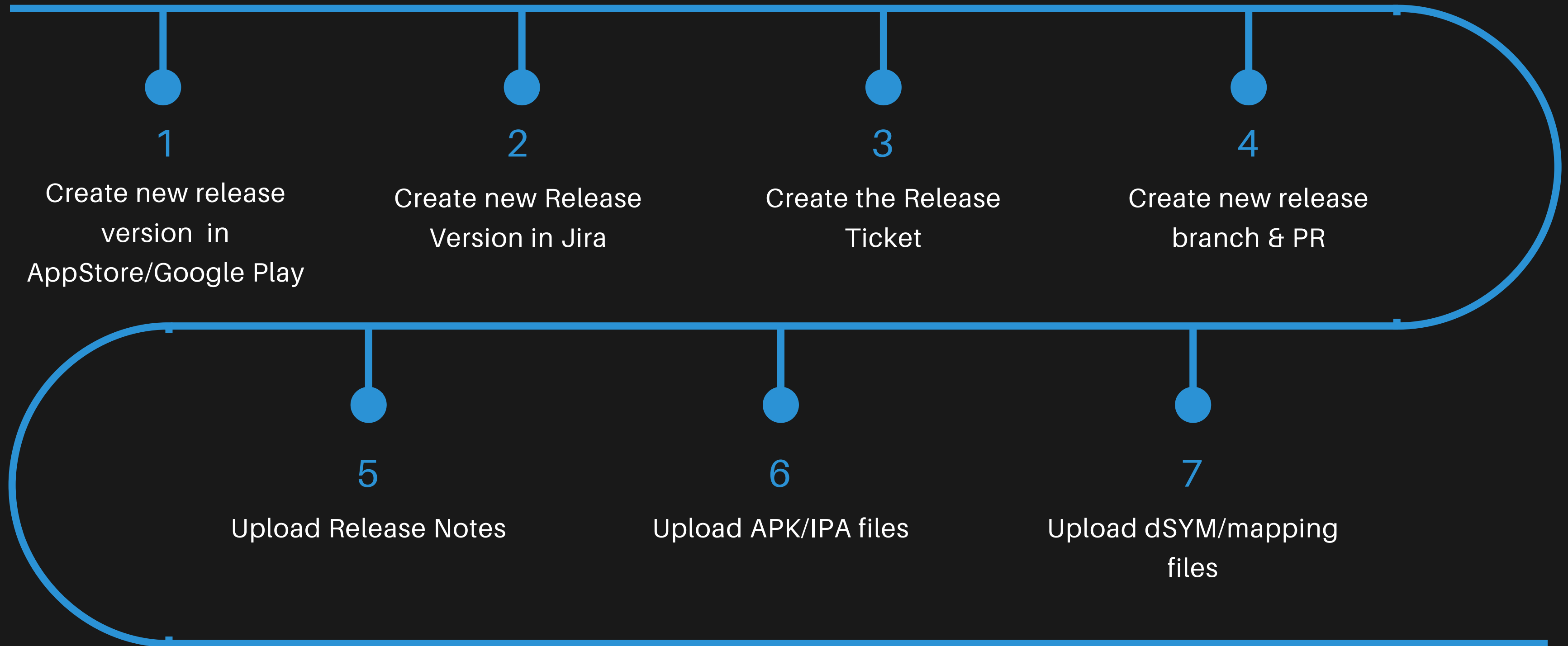

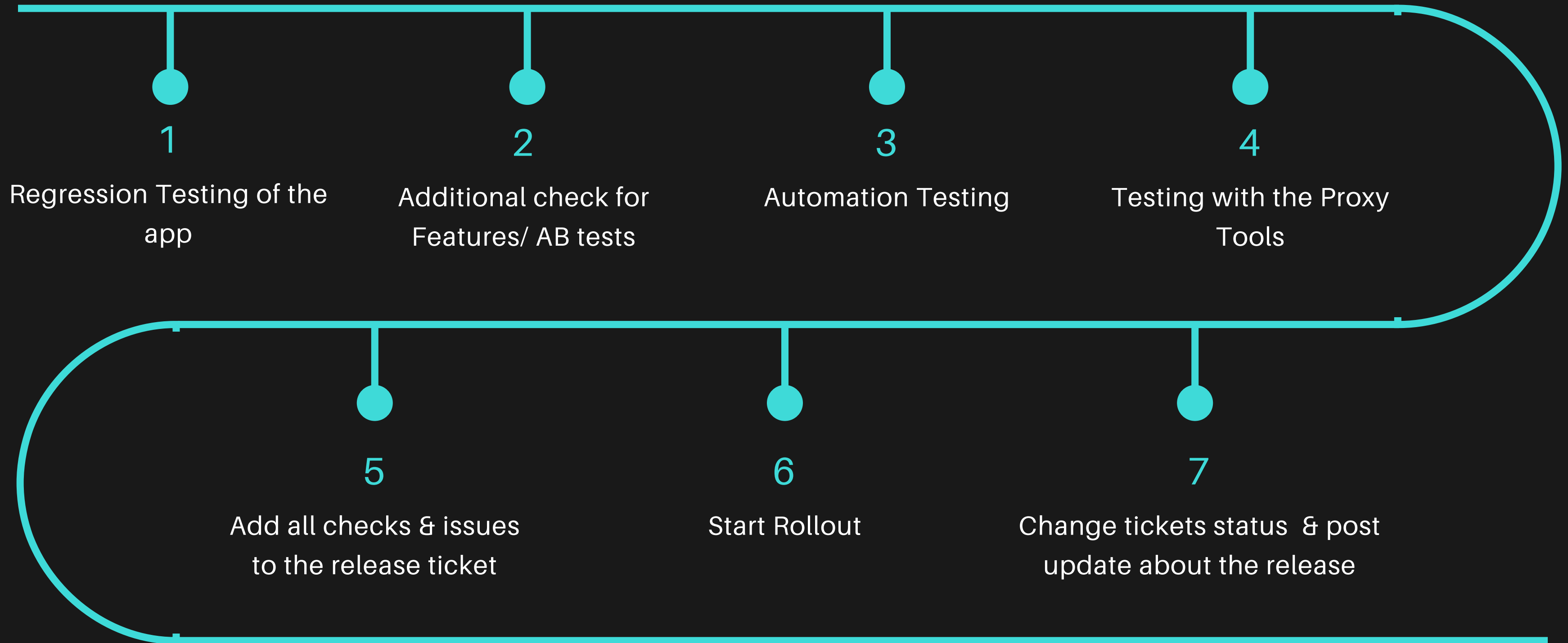

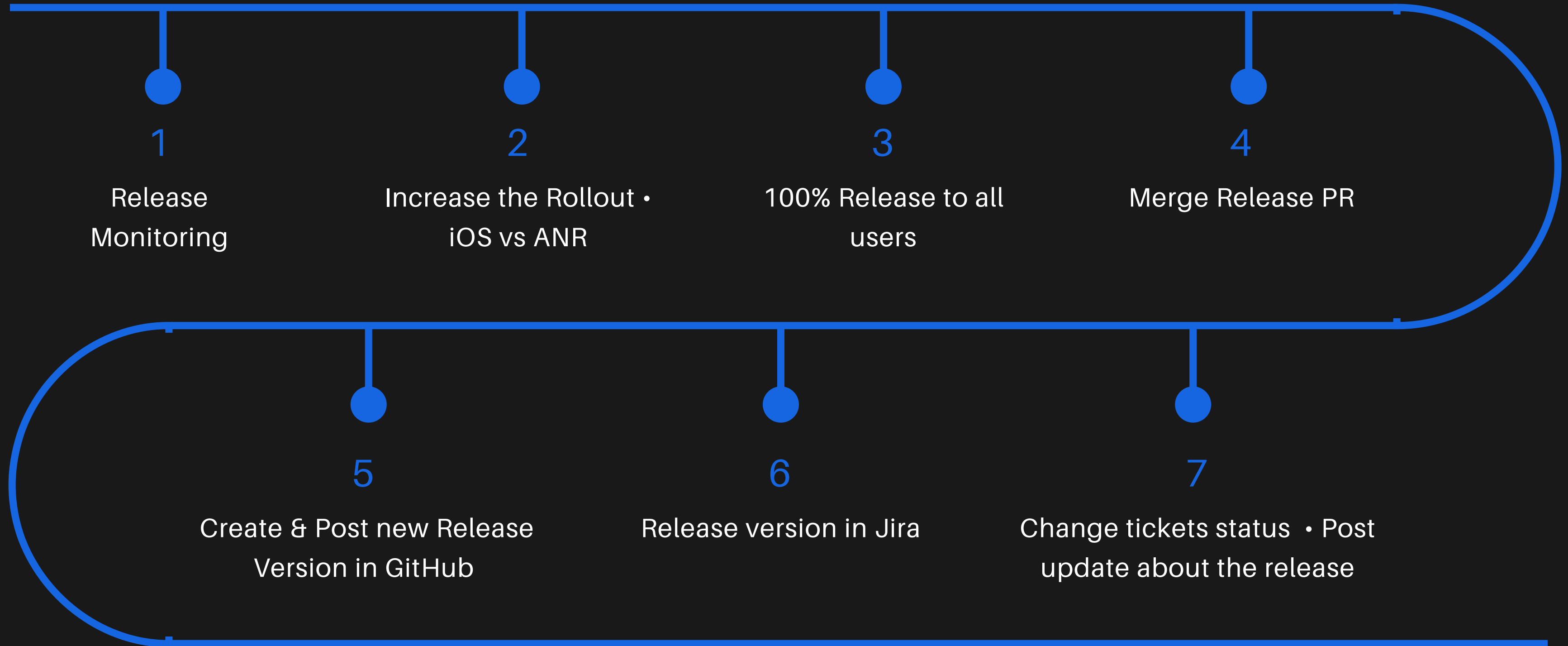

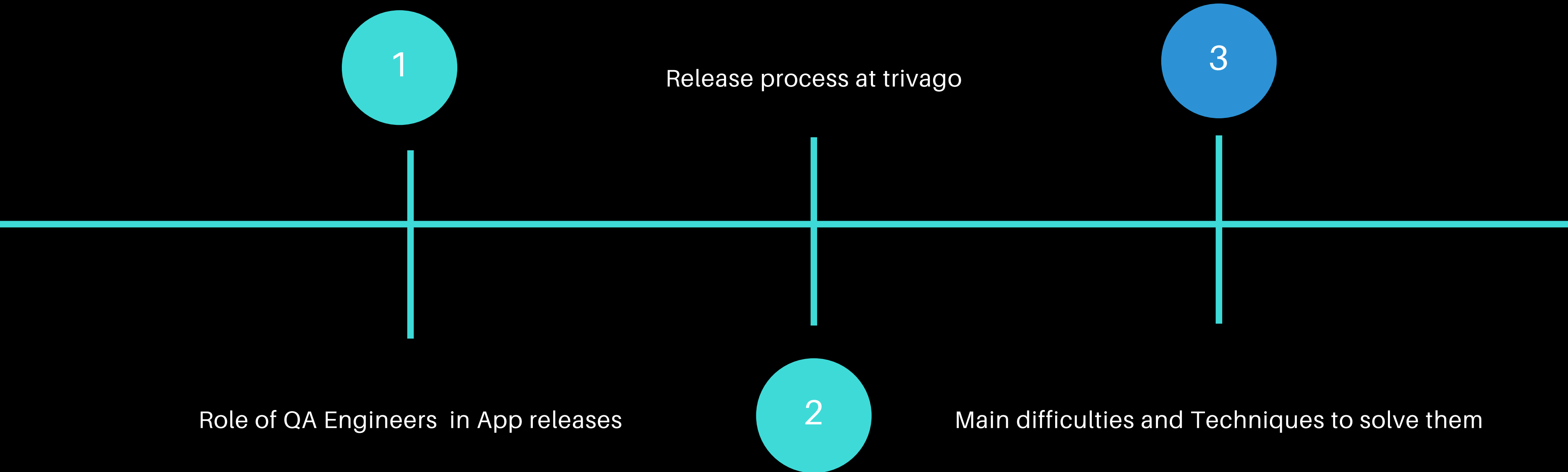
Doesn't matter how good you test you cannot exclude bugs

Emergency Measures

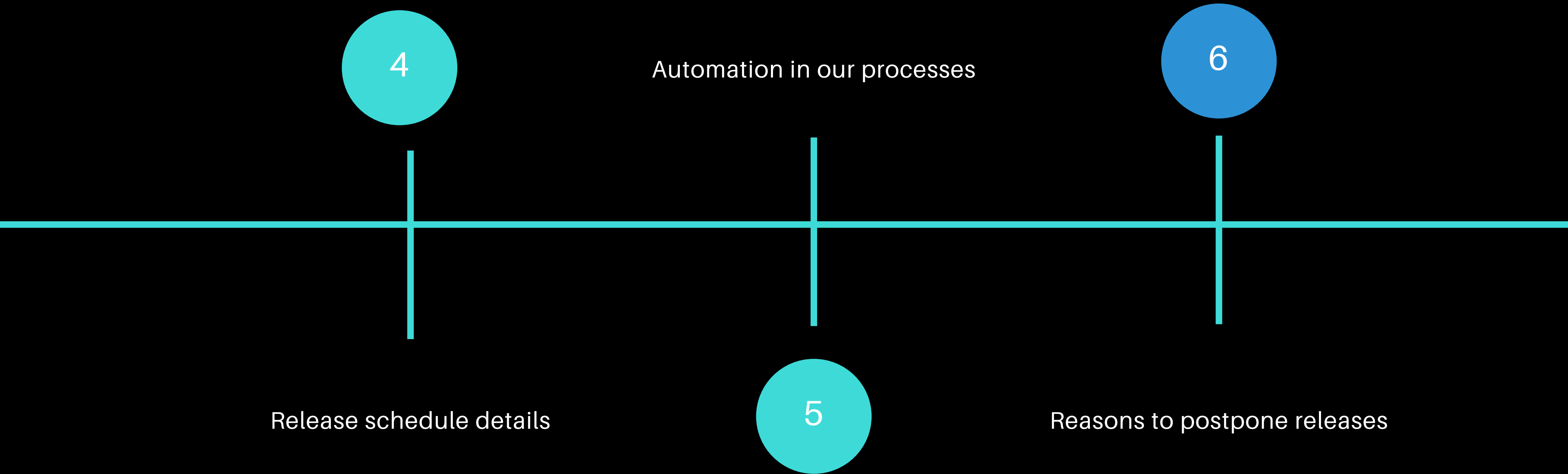
- Hot - Fixes for critical bugs
- Feature Flag to force app update
- Halt / Resume Release
- AB - Tests deactivation
